Create India Index and Assign to Nodal Ministry

> DMEO Creates India Index and Assigns to Nodal Admin

Create Tree Structure and Create Global Index

> Nodal Admin Creates Tree Structure by creating Themes, Parameters and Sub Parameters for India Index

Copy India Index to Create Global Index (Select Themes, Parameter Levels) Map Global Index with Countries & Users

> Global Index is mapped with Countries

Map Global Index with Nodal Data Entry Users Data Entry at Theme and Parameter Level & Submit for Approval

> Nodal Data Entry Users enters the Data/Scores for specific Nodal Ministry

Submits the same for approval to respective Nodal Admin Approval of the Data Entry & Data Visualization

> Nodal Admin approves the Data Entry


After Approval Scores are available under Visualization

### **04 Global Index Structure**

### **Global Index -Structure**



- DMEO/Nodal Administrator creates Global Index from India Index (Copy Function)
- Global Indices are mapped to respective Nodal Data Entry Users by Nodal Administrators
- Data Entry users adds the scores and ranks of Countries at Index, Theme, Parameter etc. level





- 2 Click to create India Index




### Map India Index To Nodal Ministry



1. Select Index Definition >> Map India Index with Nodal Ministry/Department



















### Create Global Index & Map with Countries






- Select Year and select Index Name, Select Level .

- Now Map Countries and Users with Global Index.


Users: Nodal admin can create Global Index by Copying India Index and MAP with Countries.

Select year, Index and select Country(ies) and SAVE record. Selected Countries will be mapped with selected Global Index.


Select \*\* Create Global Index User Mapping List on "Global Index User Mapping" listing screen to Map specific Global Index with Nodal Data Entry Users.

#### Select "Global Index User Mapping" from left menu;




- Select year, Index and select Users (multi select) and SAVE record.

Select "Progress Data Entry >> Global Index Data Entry" from left menu;




Click on the Index Link to Enter Scores/Ranks to Themes, Parameters and Sub-Parameters.

Enter Score /Rank to Theme, Parameters and Sub-Parameters;




Click • icon to Add Score /Rank.

- 1 Click Download sample Template icon to Download Sample template to enter Scores and Rank.








# 07 Data Entry Approval by Nodal Admin

### Data Entry Approval by Nodal Admin




 Once Data Entry done at Nodal Data Entry Level, then the record is sent for approval to respective Nodal Admin;

- You can Create Global Index, Copying India Index Only Once.
- Themes and Parameters Added after adding Global Index are not reflected in respective India Index.
- Nomenclature: India Index carries "\_India" and Global Index not.
- You can Select the Level, Index, Theme, Parameter/Sub Parameter while Creating Global Index.

- India Index is created by DMEO Administrator
- Nodal Admin creates Themes and Parameter and copies India Index to create Global Index
- Global Index is mapped with Countries and Nodal Data Entry Users
- Nodal Data Entry users does Data Entry and sends to respective Nodal Admin for approval
- Approved Scores can be viewed under Visualization
